Water Usage Activity Chart

NOTE: This activity should be done in conjunction with the Bible lesson [Taking Care of God's Gifts](#)

- Age Group** Children in grades K – 6
- Materials** A teacher or parent should use the Water Use Chart (next page) and provide one to each child with instructions of how to fill it out. (Examples provided.)
- Activity** Each child should take the chart home, and over a period of one day or one week, try to fill in the chart every time he or she uses water.
- Reflection** The children can either keep their charts at home to remind them of the gift of clean water, or bring the charts back to class. The parent or teacher can ask children to talk about the ways they used water and if they are grateful for clean water.
