



A Step Further Fundraising for Turn on the Tap



Chores and Allowance Activity

Help provide safe drinking water for a family of eight to 10 people as a class, group, or individual. This activity is intended to help you find creative ways to fund-raise.

Age group: Grades K- 6

Objective: Help teach the children that even a small gift will go a long way towards helping others.

Explanation: A teacher or parent should read Mark 12:41-43 and explain to the children that God cherishes even our smallest gifts when we are giving to Him because we love Him. The teacher or parent will explain that as a group, we are going to give a little bit of what we have to someone else by raising money to help a family in the developing world get safe water.

Activity: Children will be asked to look into their hearts to see if they can give up one allowance to God or do chores and earn some money. The teacher or parent will collect the money and put it towards Samaritan's Purse's Turn on the Tap water projects.

Get Creative: Collect the funds in a cardboard or paper BioSand Water Filter, or cut the top off an empty water bottle for the children to fill.
