Samaritan's Purse is a Christian international relief organization providing spiritual and physical aid to hurting people around the world. Since 1970, Samaritan's Purse has helped meet the needs of people who are victims of war, poverty, natural disasters, disease, and famine with the purpose of sharing God's love through His Son, Jesus Christ.

Samaritan's Purse Canada (SPC) has a ministry opportunity in Dease Lake, BC with a focus on bringing the Gospel of Jesus Christ to this Northern community and surrounding area. A kitchen ministry program has been initiated, focused on bringing Christian values and the ethos of Samaritan's Purse into a food service environment for staff and community members to be exposed to and explore Christian Faith.

We are currently looking for a Ministry Cook to coordinate the kitchen ministry, prepare meals, and build relationships within the community. The Ministry Cook will be responsible to purchase and acquire the goods required for food service and lead a partnership between the kitchen team and front of house staff. This individual will participate in and supervise a team that prepares meals for ministry events, and volunteers at the Dease Lake Ministry Centre. These individuals will help SPC carry out its mission and objectives through participation in daily prayer ministry and the aforementioned functions as an integral member of the Dease Lake Team.

On-site accommodations and meals will be available; reasonable transportation to the field site will be arranged.

Qualifications:

- Qualified applicants should be committed to Christian values and precepts and be in agreement with the Samaritan's Purse Statement of Faith.
- Bachelor's Degree required with advanced work in Culinary Arts
- Experience in training traditional and non-traditional junior chefs in a professional setting
- 3-5 years' experience in food service management or a culinary field
- Food Safe Level 2 Certificate
- Culinary vision, and a passion for food
- Strong knowledge of back of the house systems including food cost, inventory controls and food safety
- Excellent guest and employee relations skills
- Excellent team player and interpersonal skills
- Organized; detail-oriented; takes initiative
- Strong motivational skills and requires minimum supervision to meet deadlines
- Able to work in a high energy fast paced environment
- Criminal Background Check, with Vulnerable Sector, to be provided to Human Resources within the probationary period of a new hire and updated every 2 years thereafter (at the organization's expense)
