This individual will participate in the support of software and web based applications, data transformation services, SQL queries and report generation. As an integral member of the Information Technology department, this role will help SPC carry out its mission and objectives through participation in daily prayer ministry. The successful candidate will fulfill a full-time permanent position in the Calgary office.

## **Key Responsibilities:**

- Develops, maintains and offers support in the following areas: web based applications; SQL scripts for database queries and reporting; software applications in C#; websites and web applications using C#, ASP.Net, .Net Core, MVC, JavaScript, jQuery and Vue.js; web APIs and adjoining technologies.
- Assists in the maintenance of software applications, web applications and SSIS packages.
- Ensures applications are developed based on defined requirements in a timely manner.
- Documents tools, techniques and procedures necessary to support the programming function.
- Demonstrates initiative to remain current in the areas of computer applications and business processes necessary to perform this role (i.e. SharePoint, Microsoft Dynamics CRM, JavaScript frameworks, .Net development technologies).
- Participates in ongoing Information Technology process improvements in the Software Development Lifecycle, including planning, development, testing, deployment and implementation.
- Provides end user training to staff as necessary.
- Participates in site requirements analysis, system design and development.
- Assists the Information Technology Team in meeting the needs of client departments as directed.
- Responds to requests for support with software systems and related information requests.

## **Qualifications:**

- Qualified applicants should be committed to Christian values and precepts and be in agreement with the Samaritan's Purse Statement of Faith.
- Bachelor's degree/diploma in Computer Information Systems or related discipline preferred.
- Computer Application knowledge required in .Net Development in C# (3-5 years); ASP.Net 3.5/4.0+; SQL Server (3-5 Years); SQL Reporting Services; Microsoft Office, JavaScript (including jQuery and Vue.js).
- PHP and Linux experience considered an asset.
- SharePoint experience is considered an asset.
- Microsoft Dynamics CRM experience is considered an asset.
- Detail oriented, consistent, accurate and efficient.
- Excellent trouble shooting skills and ability to understand complex processes.
- Keeps abreast of emerging technologies.
- General understanding of accounting principles and inventory systems.
