PRAYER TEAM VOLUNTEER INTERVIEW QUESTIONS



These questions serve as examples of ones you might ask, and are designed to target the attitudes and competencies desired for the specific role. Time will not allow you to ask every one of these questions, but every interview should touch on each of the 7Cs.

Be sure to ask additional questions if needed to get a complete understanding of all 7Cs, and write down only what the applicant said, not your interpretation of their answers.

CALLING: what we love to do and do really well

What do you love to do and feel like you do really well?

When it comes to volunteering, in what areas do you experience the most joy?

What skills and gifts has God given you?

What aspects of the ministry description excite you most about this volunteer role?

When did you first sense a desire to intercede for people or ministry?

CHARACTER: having a strong developed Christian character

How do you think a co-worker or friend would describe you?

Share with me a time when you had to work through a conflict with someone you worked or served with.

Tell me about a time when things didn't go the way you wanted – for example, a promotion you wanted but didn't get, or a project that didn't turn out how you had hoped...how did you handle it? What did you learn from the experience?

How have you seen prayer as an effective tool to battle spiritual warfare? Tell me an experience you've had with spiritual warfare. How did you find prayer effective in that?

COMPATIBILITY: what this candidate will bring to the team

What does being on a team mean to you?

What gifts or talents do you feel you would bring to the team?

Based on what you know of this role, how do you see the power of prayer being critical to the ministry of OCC?

COMPETENCY: demonstrated skills that best predict future performance

What previous experience have you had in a formalized intercessory prayer role with your church or other organizations?

What are some creative ways you've engaged different types of people in prayer?

Share any experiences you've had leading or organizing a prayer event.

Tell me about a time you've prayed a prayer out of desperation. Besides the Bible, is there a powerful book/quote/sermon you've read/heard that has influenced your prayer

COMMITMENT: demonstrated commitment in previous volunteer positions or other areas

How long have you been at your church?

Tell me about situation when you had to stick to something in difficult circumstances.

CONDITION: mental, physical, and spiritual readiness to serve

I'd love to hear more about your testimony coming to know the Lord...

What do you do to keep in good spiritual shape?

Describe your own prayer life. What are you doing right now in prayer?

Did you get a chance to read over our Statement of Faith? Do you have any questions or concerns?

CONSISTENCY: responses and actions should remain consistent throughout the interview process

Tell me about a time when were you involved on a team, either at work at church or in the community serving; how does that connect with this volunteer position? (is he/she being consistent in their answers)

Share with me about a time you had to step outside your comfort zone to serve Christ...what was it like? What helped you get through it?

Is there anything you'd like to say about your consideration for this volunteer position?
