Summary

Mobilize students, student groups, and schools within your area to become actively involved in sharing the hope of Jesus Christ through Operation Christmas Child (OCC).



Primary Responsibilities

- Represent OCC year round within your area to effectively promote and facilitate shoebox generation to students and student groups
- Equip student organizations to conduct packing parties
- Promote The Greatest Journey initiative as appropriate
- Be available to represent OCC at relevant conferences and community events
- Communicate consistently with the Student Relations Coordinator

Qualifications

Spiritually mature Christian with strong interpersonal and communication skills. Must be connected to and knowledgeable of designated area and be committed to the ministry goals of SP/OCC. Must feel called to serve area schools, students, and student organizations. Regular access to an individual email account and MyOCC is required.

Training Expectations

- Participate in initial meeting with Student Relations Coordinator and online training
- Participate in Annual and Ministry Specific training
- · Attend regional events and Area Team meetings
- Attend annual Connect Conference (encouraged)

Volunteer Time Commitment

- One year, may hold ministry position for multiple terms. Term may be ended at any time by volunteer or OCC Regional Point of Contact
- Time commitment of 1 to 3 hours per week, likely increasing to 5 to 10 hours per week during peak months

We believe that all men everywhere are lost and face the judgment of God, that Jesus Christ is the only way of salvation, and that for the salvation of lost and sinful man, repentance of sin and faith in Jesus Christ results in regeneration by the Holy Spirit. Luke 24:46-47; John 14:6; Acts 4:12; Romans 3:23; 2 Corinthians 5:10-11; Ephesians 1:7 and 2:8-9; Titus 3:4-7.

We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, whose indwelling enables the Christian to live a godly life. *John 3:5-8; Acts 1:8 and 4:31; Romans 8:9; 1 Corinthians 2:14; Galatians 5:16-18; Ephesians 6:12; Colossians 2:6-10.*

We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; the saved unto the resurrection of eternal life and the lost unto the resurrection of damnation and eternal punishment. 1 Corinthians 15:51-57; Revelation 20:11-15.

We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in the Lord Jesus Christ and that all true believers are members of His body, the church. 1 Corinthians 12:12, 27; Ephesians1:22-23.

We believe that the ministry of evangelism and discipleship is a responsibility of all followers of Jesus Christ. *Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Romans 10:9-15; 1 Peter 3:15.*

We believe God's plan for human sexuality is to be expressed only within the context of marriage, that God created man and woman as unique biological persons made to complete each other. God instituted monogamous marriage between male and female as the foundation of the family and the basic structure of human society. For this reason, we believe that marriage is exclusively the union of one genetic male and one genetic female. *Genesis 2:24; Matthew 19:5-6; Mark 10:6-9; Romans 1:26-27; 1Corinthians 6:9.*

We believe that we must dedicate ourselves to prayer, to the service of our Lord, to His authority over our lives, and to the ministry of evangelism. *Matthew 9:35-38; 22:37-39, and 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Romans 10:9-15 and 12:20-21; Galatians 6:10; Colossians 2:6-10; 1 Peter 3:15.*

We believe that human life is sacred from conception to its natural end; and that we must have concern for the physical and spiritual needs of our fellowmen. *Psalm 139:13; Isaiah 49:1; Jeremiah 1:5; Matthew 22:37-39; Romans 12:20-21; Galatians 6:10.*
